# Glossary

<b>Users</b>	The users of the application, including both organizations and individuals
<b>Organizations</b>	Users representing nonprofits, companies, or philanthropic groups
<b>Individuals</b>	Individual users of the app aiming to support a philanthropic cause
<b>Cause</b>	The philanthropic category that aligns with the organizations and their events. Causes could be general (health), specific (lung cancer), or religious (Christian).
<b>Skills</b>	These are skills that the individuals would have. Skills include knowing how to cook, knowing how to sew, knowing how to draw, knowing how to give speeches, and many more. These also include having resources such as time, money, or a car.



## AC-1.1. Register

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As a user, I want to have an account so that my session is remembered and my information is saved.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click on the "<b>Continue with Google</b>" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall select an account to continue.</li><li>3. The tester shall select "<b>Individual</b>".</li></ol>
<b>Alternate Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. The tester shall click on the "<b>Continue with Facebook</b>" button.</li><li>5. The tester shall select an account to continue.</li><li>6. The tester shall select "<b>Organization</b>".</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The tester shall be redirected to the Profile Creation page.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The tester is redirected to the Profile Creation page.

## AC-1.2: Login

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As a user, I want to log in with my Google/Facebook associated account, so that I can use the application.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click the "<b>Continue with Google</b>" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall press "Sign In".</li></ol>
<b>Alternate Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click the "<b>Continue with Facebook</b>" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall press "Sign In".</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The tester shall be redirected to the Home Page.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The tester is redirected to the Home Page.



### AC-1.3: Logout

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As a user, I want to be able to log out of my account so that I can secure my account data.
<b>Workflow</b>	1. The tester shall click on the “ <b>Log out</b> ” button.
<b>Expected Result</b>	The tester shall be redirected to the login screen.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The tester is redirected to the login screen.

### AC-1.4: Continue as Guest

<b>Priority</b>	3 - Nice to Have
<b>Status</b>	Dropped
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to continue as a guest so that I can use the application.
<b>Workflow</b>	1. The tester shall click on the "Continue as Guest" button.
<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be redirected to the guest home page.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester is redirected to the guest home page.



## AC-2.1: Create User Profile

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As a user, I want to have an account so that my profile is personalized and specified as an individual or organization.
<b>Workflow Individual</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall fill in their information in the fields they choose: for individual users, these include the mandatory fields "First Name", "Last Name", "Zip", "Age", and optional fields "Causes", "Skills".</li><li>2. The tester shall click the "Create" button.</li></ol>
<b>Workflow Organization</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall fill in their information in the fields they choose: for organization users, these include the mandatory fields "Title", "Mission", "Zip", "Contact", "URL" and optional field "Causes".</li><li>2. The tester shall click the "Create" button.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be redirected to the home page.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester is redirected to the home page.

## AC-2.2: Edit User Profile

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As a user, I want to be able to edit my profile so that I can update my profile.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click on the "Edit" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall edit the "Zip" field.</li><li>3. The tester shall click "Save" at the bottom of the page.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The tester's "Zip" field of the tester's profile shall be displayed with the update.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The tester's "Zip" field of the tester's profile is displayed with the update.





### AC-3.1.i: Filter Organizations by Cause

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to filter organizations by cause so that I can find organizations with causes that I'm passionate about.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click on the "Find Org" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall click on the "Causes" button at the right side of the navbar.</li><li>3. The tester shall click on the "Animals" button in the dropdown menu.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be presented with an updated list of organization cards that include organizations with the "Animals" tag in their causes field.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester is presented with an updated list of organization cards that include organizations with the "Animals" tag in their causes field.

### AC-3.1.ii: Filter Organizations by Distance

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have

<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to filter organizations by distance so that I can find local organizations to support.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click on the "Find Org" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall click on the "Distance" button at the right side of the navbar.</li><li>3. The tester shall use the slider to specify a search radius of 500km.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be presented with an updated list of organization cards that include organizations within the search radius of 500km.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester is presented with an updated list of organization cards that include organizations within the search radius of 500km.



### AC-3.2.i: Filter Events by Skills

<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be presented with an updated list of event cards that include events with the "Cooking" tag in their skills field.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester shall be presented with an updated list of event cards that include events with the "Cooking" tag in their skills field.

### AC-3.2.ii: Filter Events by Distance

<b>Priority</b>	2 - Should Have

<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to filter events by distance so that I can find local organizations to support.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The tester shall click on the "Find Event" button.</li><li>2. The tester shall click on the "Distance" button at the right side of the navbar.</li><li>3. The tester shall use the slider to specify a search radius of 500km.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The tester shall be presented with an updated list of event cards that include events within the search radius of 500km.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The tester is presented with an updated list of event cards that include events within the search radius of 500km.



### **AC-4.1: Manage Events (Organization)**

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an organization user, I want to be able to manage my events on my news feed so that I can edit or delete event posts.
<b>Test Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The organization tester shall click on the "Home" page button from the navbar.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The organization tester sees their posts on their news feed, or a message instructing them to create a post.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The organization tester sees their posts on their news feed, or a message instructing them to create a post.

### **AC-4.2: Discover Following Organization's Events (Individual)**

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to view my personalized news feed so that I can discover events from organizations that I follow.
<b>Test Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The individual tester shall follow an organization that has an event, found on the "Find Org" page.</li><li>2. The individual tester shall click on the "Home" page button from the navbar.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The individual tester shall see the event from the organization the tester has followed.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The individual tester sees the event from the organization the tester has followed.



## AC-5.1: Create Event

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an organization user, I want to be able to create event posts so that individuals can view our events and connect with us.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The organization tester shall click on the "Post" tab.</li><li>2. The organization tester shall enter required fields on information about their event, including the fields "Title", "Details", "Zip", "Date", and the optional field "Skills".</li><li>3. The organization tester shall then click "Create".</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The organization tester shall be presented with the event post on their home page news feed.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The organization tester is presented with the event post on their home page news feed.

## AC-5.2: Edit Event

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an organization user, I want to be able to edit event posts so that people can receive updated information for our events.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The organization tester shall click the "Edit / Delete" button on the event they want to edit.</li><li>2. The organization tester shall edit required fields on information about their event, including the fields "Title", "Details", "Zip", "Date", and the optional field "Skills".</li><li>3. The organization tester shall then click "Save".</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	The organization tester shall be presented with the updated event post on their home page news feed.
<b>Actual Results</b>	The organization tester is presented with the updated event post on their home page news feed.



### **AC-5.3: Delete Event**

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an organization user, I want to be able to delete an event from our news feed so that people see only correct and intended information.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The organization tester shall click the "Edit / Delete" button on the event they want to delete.</li><li>2. The organization tester shall click "Delete" at the bottom of the popup.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Results</b>	On the home page news feed, the organization tester shall see that the event post has been removed.
<b>Actual Results</b>	On the home page news feed, the organization tester sees that the event post has been removed.

### **AC-6.1.i: Follow Organization**

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to follow an organization so that I can see their events on my news feed.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The individual tester shall press the follow organization "+" button on an organization card with an event, found on the "Find Org" page.</li><li>2. The individual tester shall click on the "Home" page button from the navbar.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The individual tester shall see the event from the organization the tester has followed.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The individual tester sees the event from the organization the tester has followed.



## AC-6.1.ii: Unfollow Organization

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to unfollow an organization so that I can remove their events from my news feed.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The individual tester shall press the unfollow organization "✓" button on an organization card that they are already following with an event, found on the "Find Org" page.</li><li>2. The individual tester shall click on the "Home" page button from the navbar.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The individual tester shall no longer see that the event from the organization the tester had followed is now gone.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The individual tester no longer sees that the event from the organization the tester had followed is now gone.

## AC-6.2: View Organization's Information

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to view an organization's information so that I can learn about their mission and needs.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The individual tester shall click on an organization card found on the "Find Org" page.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The individual user shall be presented with a pop-up containing the organization's information.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The individual user is presented with a pop-up containing the organization's information.



### **AC-6.3: View Event's Information**

<b>Priority</b>	1 - Must Have
<b>Status</b>	Complete
<b>Description</b>	As an individual user, I want to be able to view an event's information so that I can see if I can help out.
<b>Workflow</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The individual tester shall click on an event card found on the "Find Event" page.</li></ol>
<b>Expected Result</b>	The individual user shall be presented with a pop-up containing the event's information.
<b>Actual Result</b>	The individual user is presented with a pop-up containing the event's information.
